REGISTRATION AND SECURITY

- Registration will open at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 2, 2016.
- Please bring your government issued photo ID (driver's license, passport.) You will be required to present it when you check-in.
- For security reasons, all visitors to the World Bank are required to pass through a metal detector and all visitors' bags are X-rayed.
- On arrival at the World Bank, please enter through the main entrance of the Main Complex which is on H street NW (1818 H Street, NW). Please do not enter through the visitor's entry. There will be a security guard and signage to guide you.
- As you pass through security, you will be directed to the registration tables (after the metal detectors). Here you will register and pick up your World Bank visitor's pass (which will grant you access to World Bank buildings until 6 p.m. on November 3), as well as a conference badge and materials.
- Visitor's passes are mandatory for all participants who are not World Bank Group or IMF staff.
