Travel: Flights

Travel: Airport transfers & local transport

Cape Town International Airport is approx. 20 km/12.4 miles from the city centre.

The DPRU organising team have an arrangement with a reputable local small business, **S.I. City Bowl Shuttles** (Emergency contact: Shaheed on +27(0)82 694 1122) to provide transfers for both arrival and return trips to and from the airport. Should you wish to make use of this service, please send your travel details (name, flight number, arrival time, and contact cell/mobile number) via email to j4d@jobsanddevelopmentconference.org. Please note that the driver will greet you holding a signboard marked “#Jobs4Dev”, in the arrivals areas outside the baggage claim, inside the airport.

Should you prefer to make your own local travel arrangements, there is safe, inexpensive public transport via the [MyCiTi bus](#) network. The MyCiTi station sits right outside the main Airport terminal, and buses on the A01 Airport - Civic Centre route depart every 20 minutes (approx. 30mins journey time). Connect at the Civic Centre to the T01 route to the V&A Waterfront (approx. 15mins journey time). [Uber](#) offers one of the easiest ways to get around Cape Town. Various fleets of metered taxis are also available, such as Excite taxis (Tel: +27(0)21 448 4444).




Visiting Cape Town

MISC Info

- Please note that the *Day of Reconciliation* is a public holiday in South Africa held annually on 16 December, so some businesses may be closed on the Friday after the conference.
- Exchange rates (South African Rands ZAR)
Approx: US\$1 = R16.50 | £1 = R20.00 | €1 = R16.90 | ¥ 1 = R2.50
- Dress code: Business attire.
- Weather: Cape Town enjoys a temperate climate with warm, dry conditions from October to April. This part of the Western Cape is a winter rainfall area and December only averages 5-6 days of rain on average.
 - Average minimum temperatures at night = 14-15°C (58-60°F)
 - Average maximum daytime temperatures lie around 24-25°C (76-77°F).
- Safety: Consider watching this [12 tips video](#) that includes advice on hiking in groups, swimming only when lifeguards are on duty, being discreet with belongings (especially cell/mobile phones and cameras) when out in public, and only using reliable transport.
